'DOUBLE' ADMITS HIS GUILT

**Pleads to Robbery for Which
Another Man Had Been Tried**

Charles J. Daniell, 38 years old, of 89-04 Thirty-fourth Avenue Jackson Heights, Queens, pleaded guilty yesterday to a robbery for which another man, who looked like him, had been arrested. Daniell had admitted this crime when arrested in a hold-up in April.

Christopher E. Balestrero, 43, of 41-20 Seventy-third Street, Jackson Heights is the man who had been tried for the crime to which Daniell pleaded guilty before Queens County Judge John F. Scilleppi. Mr. Balestrero's case ended in a mistrial.
